RESOLUTION NO. 68-12

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 2: SUMMIT DRIVE ANNEXATION (1967-2).

WHEREAS, Sanitary District No. 2 of Marin County Resolution No. 17-67, a Resolution of Application to annex certain territory, has been filed with the Executive Officer; and

WHEREAS, at the times and in the forms and manner provided by law the Executive Officer has given notice of a public hearing by this Commission on said Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing by this Commission was held on April 4, 1968.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Marin does hereby resolve, determine, and order as follows:

1. Resolution No. 17-67 of Sanitary District No. 2 is approved, subject to the terms and conditions contained therein.
2. The territory proposed for annexation shall be designated as Summit Drive Annexation (1967-2).
3. Sanitary District No. 2 shall be the conducting district for further proceedings to annex this territory and the Board of Directors of that district is directed to initiate annexation proceedings in compliance with this resolution and if any election is ordered, it shall be held only in the territory to be annexed.
4. The resolution of the conducting district ordering such annexation shall provide that the annexation shall be subject to the same terms and conditions that are contained in the resolution of application (Resolution No. 17-67) of Sanitary District No. 2 and as are contained herein.





BEGINNING at the Westerly corner of Lot 124 as the name is shown on that certain map entitled "Amended Map of Corte Madera Woods", filed March 16, 1912, in Map Book 4, at Page 16, Marin County Records; and running thence along the Southwesterly boundary of Lot 124, South  $45^{\circ} 22'$  East 125 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot 124; thence North  $44^{\circ} 38'$  East 25 feet more or less to the existing boundary of Sanitary District No. 2; said point also being a point on the former boundary between Corte Madera and Larkspur as described in Corte Madera City Ordinance No. 478 dated June 19, 1967; thence due South along said Sanitary District Boundary 425 feet more or less; thence due West along said boundary 587 feet more or less to the intersection of the said Sanitary District No. 2 of Marin County Boundary with the northerly line of North Trail as shown on the said "Amended Map of Corte Madera Woods"; thence North  $44^{\circ} 38'$  East along said northerly line of North Trail 688 feet more or less to the point of beginning.
