RESOLUTION NO. 65-2

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO:

LAS GALLINAS VALLEY SANITARY DISTRICT

TERRA LINDA UNIT 24 (1965-3)

WHEREAS, a resolution of application has been filed, together with evidence of written consent of all owners of property within the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has found the territory to be annexed to be uninhabited; and

WHEREAS, the Las Gallinas Valley Sanitary District has not requested the Commission to hold a noticed public hearing in accordance with Government Code Section 56261.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Marin County Local Agency Formation Commission, in accordance with the District Reorganization Act of 1965, that it does hereby approve the annexation of territory known as Terra Linda Unit 24 (1965-3) to the Las Gallinas Valley Sanitary District with the following determinations:

1. The Las Gallinas Valley Sanitary District shall be the conducting District for further proceedings to annex this territory and the Board of Directors of that District is directed to initiate annexation proceedings in compliance with this resolution. Such proceedings may be without notice of hearing and without election.


2. The territory proposed for annexation shall be designated as Terra Linda Unit 24 (1965-3).
