RESOLUTION NO. 66-2

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO:

SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 6:

CAMPANELLI ANNEXATION (1965-15)

WHEREAS, a resolution of application has been filed, together with evidence of written consent of all owners of property within the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has found the territory to be annexed to be uninhabited; and

WHEREAS, the Sanitary District No. 6 has not requested the Commission to hold a noticed public hearing in accordance with Government Code Section 56261.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Marin County Local Agency Formation Commission, in accordance with the District Reorganization Act of 1965, that it does hereby approve the annexation of territory known as the ~~Campanelli~~ Annexation (1965-15) to Sanitary District No. 6 with the following determinations:

1. Sanitary District No. 6 shall be the conducting District for further proceedings to annex this territory and the Board of Directors of that District are directed to initiate annexation proceedings in compliance with this resolution. Such proceedings may be without notice of hearing and without election.


2. The territory proposed for annexation shall be designated as the Campanelli Annexation (1965-15).

EXHIBIT "A"

Parcel B

BEGINNING at a point on the existing boundary of Sanitary District No. 6 of Marin County, said point being on the Northerly line of Vineyard Road, distant thereon North  $89^{\circ} 42' 36''$  East 467.70 feet from the intersection of said Northerly line of Vineyard Road with the Easterly line of Eucalyptus Avenue, as shown on that certain map entitled "Amended Map No. 1 of Subdivision E of the Novato Ranch, Marin County, Calif.", filed July 6, 1910 in Book 3 of Maps at Page 54, Marin County Records; said point of beginning being also distant South  $89^{\circ} 42'$  West 30.48 feet and North  $9^{\circ} 52'$  East 20.32 feet from the most Southeasterly corner of that certain parcel of land conveyed by Primo Paladini, to Glenn S. Goble et ux, recorded by deed on July 21, 1949 in Liber 610 at Page 52, Marin County Records; running thence from said point of beginning along said Sanitary District boundary and along said Northerly line of Vineyard Road South  $89^{\circ} 42' 36''$  West 125.67 feet; thence leaving said Sanitary District boundary and said Northerly line of Vineyard Road North  $9^{\circ} 52'$  East 242.795 feet; thence North  $78^{\circ} 34'$  East 132.769 feet; thence South  $9^{\circ} 52'$  West 268.8 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

PARCEL A

BEGINNING at a point on the existing boundary of Sanitary District No. 6 of Marin County, said point being at the intersection of the center line of Dominic Drive with the Southerly boundary of St. Francis Heights Unit Four as the same is shown upon the map thereof filed for record in Book 11 of Maps, at Page 84, Marin County Records; thence along said Sanitary District boundary and along said Southerly boundary of St. Francis Heights Unit Four North  $75^{\circ} 45'$  West 302.45 feet; thence leaving said Sanitary District boundary and said Southerly boundary of St. Francis Heights Unit Four South  $14^{\circ} 15'$  West 222.17 feet; thence South  $75^{\circ} 45'$  East 219.75 feet; thence Northerly along the arc of a curve concave to the Southeast with a radius of 140 feet through a central angle of  $28^{\circ} 51' 20''$  and tangent at the Northerly terminus thereof to the succeeding course, a distance of 70.51 feet; thence North  $43^{\circ} 06'$  East 99.36 feet; thence Northerly along the arc of a curve concave to the Northwest with a radius of 140 feet through a central angle of  $28^{\circ} 51' 20''$  and tangent at the Southerly terminus thereof to the preceding course a distance of 70.51 feet to the point of beginning.
