RESOLUTION NO. 65-4

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO:

SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 6

NOVATO PLANT SITE EXPANSION ANNEXATION (1965-12)

WHEREAS, a resolution of application has been filed, together with evidence of written consent of all owners of property within the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has found the territory to be annexed to be uninhabited; and

WHEREAS, the Sanitary District No. 6 has not requested the Commission to hold a noticed public hearing in accordance with Government Code Section 56261.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Marin County Local Agency Formation Commission, in accordance with the District Reorganization Act of 1965, that it does hereby approve the annexation of territory known as Novato Plant Site Expansion Annexation (1965-12) to Sanitary District No. 6 with the following determinations:

1. Sanitary District No. 6 shall be the conducting District for further proceedings to annex this territory and the Board of Directors of that District is directed to initiate annexation proceedings in compliance with this resolution. Such proceedings may be without notice of hearing and without election.


2. The territory proposed for annexation shall be designated as Novato Plant Site Expansion Annexation (1965-12).



EXHIBIT "A"

NOVATO PLANT SITE EXPANSION ANNEX 1965-12

BEGINNING at a point on the existing boundary of Sanitary District No. 6 of Marin County, said point being distant North $64^{\circ} 40'$ West 487.50 feet from the most Southerly corner of Lot 6 as shown on that certain map entitled, "Map of East Part Rancho de Novato, Marin County, California", filed March 22, 1889 in Rack 2 Pull 3, Marin County Records, said point being also the most Southerly corner of that parcel of land described in that certain deed from Robert McClelland and Lillian McClelland, his wife, to Sanitary District No. 6 of Marin County, recorded April 11, 1956, in Book 1020 at Page 131, Marin County Records; thence running along the Easterly boundary of said parcel of land and along said Sanitary District boundary North $38^{\circ} 54'$ East 136.075 feet; thence North $28^{\circ} 36'$ West 473.702 feet; thence North $73^{\circ} 36'$ West 141.421 feet to the most Northerly corner of said parcel of land; thence leaving the Easterly boundary of said parcel of land and said Sanitary District boundary and running North $61^{\circ} 24'$ East 604.50 feet more or less to a point on the dividing line between Lots 6 and 7 as shown on that certain map hereinabove mentioned; thence running along said dividing line South 10° East 1075.98 feet, more or less, to the most Southerly corner of said Lot 6; thence North $64^{\circ} 40'$ West 487.50 feet to the point of beginning.
