RESOLUTION NO. 68-31

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO
SANITARY DISTRICT No. 6:

TRUMBULL AVENUE NO. 2 ANNEXATION 1968-6

WHEREAS, a resolution of application No. 1034 has been filed by
Sanitary District No. 6, together with evidence of written
consent of all owners of property within the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has found the territory to be annexed to be
uninhabited; and

WHEREAS, the Sanitary District No. 6
has not requested the Commission to hold a noticed public hearing in accordance
with Government Code Section 56261.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Marin County Local Agency Forma-
tion Commission, in accordance with the District Reorganization Act of 1965, that
it does hereby approve the annexation of territory known as Trumbull Avenue
No. 2 Annexation 1968-6 to Sanitary District No. 6

with the following determinations:

1. Sanitary District No. 6 shall
be the conducting District for further proceedings to annex this territory and
the Board of Directors of that District is directed to initiate annexation pro-
ceedings in compliance with this resolution and the resolution of application.
Such proceedings may be without notice, without hearing, and without election.

2. The territory proposed for annexation shall be designated as
Trumbull Avenue No. 2 Annexation 1968-6.

EXHIBIT "A"

BEGINNING at a point on the existing boundary of Sanitary District No. 6 of Marin County, said point being on the Southeasterly line of Trumbull Ave. at its intersection with the Southwesterly line of Lot. 218 as said Road and Lot are shown upon that certain map entitled "Amended Map No. 1 of Subdivision 'C' of the Novato Ranch, Marin County, California", filed July 6, 1910 in Book 3 of Maps at Page 53, Marin County Records, said point also being a point on the boundary of Lot 269 as said Lot is shown upon that certain map entitled "Map of Subdivision 'F' of the Novato Ranch, Marin County, California", filed July 6, 1910 in Book 3 of Maps at Page 55, Marin County Records; thence leaving said Sanitary District boundary and running along the dividing line between said Lots 218 and 269 South $60^{\circ} 45'$ East 645.00 feet; thence leaving said dividing line and running along the Southeasterly line of said Lot 269 South $29^{\circ} 15' 00''$ West 2200.00 feet; thence leaving said Southeasterly boundary North $65^{\circ} 00' 00''$ West 1815 feet, more or less, to a point on the Westerly line of said Lot 269, said point being distant thereon North $8^{\circ} 44' 24''$ East 1500.00 feet from the Southwesterly corner of said Lot 269; thence along said Westerly line of Lot 269 North $8^{\circ} 44' 24''$ East 1900 feet, more or less, to a point on the existing Sanitary District boundary; thence leaving said Westerly line of Lot 269 and running along said Sanitary District boundary South $35^{\circ} 25' 00''$ East 630 feet, more or less; thence North $54^{\circ} 18' 00''$ East 385.00 feet; thence North $76^{\circ} 00' 00''$ East 698.00 feet; thence North $40^{\circ} 39' 00''$ East 392.00 feet; thence South $55^{\circ} 00' 00''$ East 218.00 feet; thence South $15^{\circ} 40' 00''$ West 428.00 feet; thence South $60^{\circ} 45'$ East 175.00 feet; thence North $29^{\circ} 15' 00''$ East 30 feet to the point of beginning.
