RESOLUTION NO. 76-20

RESOLUTION MAKING DETERMINATIONS AND APPROVING THE FORMATION OF
MARIN COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 22

WHEREAS, an application for the formation of Marin County Service Area No. 22 has been filed with the Executive Officer of this Commission; and

WHEREAS, said proposal was made in the form of application submitted by Marin County Supervisor Arnold Baptiste and requested initiation of proceedings by this Commission upon said proposal pursuant to the Knox-Nisbet Act, Chapter 6.6 (commencing with Section 54773) of Division 2, Title 5 of the Government Code; and

WHEREAS, at the time and in the form and manner prescribed by law the Executive Officer has given notice of public hearing by this Commission upon said proposal; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing on said proposal was held by this Commission upon the date and at the time and place specified in said notice of public hearing;

WHEREAS, at said hearing this Commission heard and received all oral and written protests, objections and evidence made, presented or filed;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Marin DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER as follows:

1. The boundaries of the proposed "County Service Area No. 22" shall be and are hereby amended to exclude the following properties therefrom: Assessor's Parcels Numbers 121-110-05, 121-110-06, 121-110-07, 121-110-08, and 121-110-09.

2. Subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter specified, the proposal to form County Service Area No. 22 as herein amended is approved.

3. The boundaries of the territory approved for inclusion in said County Service Area No. 22 shall be those set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein; and said territory shall be designated as "County Service Area No. 22".

4. Any resolution ordering the formation of the county service area approved by this resolution shall provide that such formation is ordered subject to the following terms and conditions:

a. Any resolution adopted pursuant to Government Code Section 25210.18 establishing Marin County Service Area No. 22 shall provide that said County Service Area is established and shall be effective only upon the condition that bonded indebtedness, in an amount determined by the Board of Supervisors as sufficient to carry out the purposes of the County Service Area, is approved by the affected voters in accordance with provisions of the County Service Area Law, Chapter 2.2 (commencing with Section 25210.1) of Division 2, Title 3 of the Government Code.

b. The Board of Supervisors shall not provide any services, other than open space acquisition and recreation services, unless and until such additional service or services have been approved by (i) LAFCo, (ii) the City Council of the City of Novato and (iii) a majority of the voters within the County Service Area.

5. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Marin has been designated as the conducting agency for further proceedings and are hereby directed to initiate said proceedings in compliance with this resolution and the applicable provisions of State Law.



RESOLUTION INDICATING THE NON-EXISTENCE

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors did form County Service Area 22 subject to conditions imposed by the Marin County Local Agency Formation Commission, and the City of Novato, and

WHEREAS, both the Local Agency Formation Commission and the City of Novato had imposed as a condition that formation of County Service Area 22 was subject to successful passage of a bond issue, and

WHEREAS, an unsuccessful bond election was conducted in County Service Area 22 on November 9, 1976,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FINDS:

That upon failure of the bond issue to pass, County Service Area 22 is deemed not to exist.
