RESOLUTION NO. 69-3

RESOLUTION APPROVING RESOLUTIONS FOR DETACHMENT OF TERRITORY
FROM THE TAMALPAIS COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT AND ANNEXATION
OF THE SAME TERRITORY TO THE SAUSALITO-MARIN CITY SANITARY DISTRICT

SHORELINE HIGHWAY REORGANIZATION

WHEREAS, Tamalpais Community Services District Resolution No. 8 and Sausalito-Marin City Sanitary District Resolution No. 274 proposing substantially the same plan of reorganization for both districts, namely, the detachment of territory along Shoreline Highway from the Tamalpais Community Services District and the annexation of the same territory to the Sausalito-Marin City Sanitary District; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Officer of this Local Agency Formation Commission has examined said resolutions and found them to be mandatory; and

WHEREAS, at the time and in the form and manner provided by law the Executive Officer has given notice of a public hearing by this Commission on said resolutions; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing by this Commission was held on the date and at the time and place specified in said notice of public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Marin does hereby resolve, determine, and order as follows:

1. The plan of reorganization specified in Tamalpais Community Services District Resolution No. 8 and in Sausalito-Marin City Sanitary District Resolution No. 274 for the detachment of territory along Shoreline Highway from Tamalpais Community Services District and the annexation of the same territory to the Sausalito-Marin City Sanitary District is hereby approved.

2. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Marin is directed to initiate proceedings in compliance with this resolution.

3. The Executive Officer is hereby authorized and directed to mail certified copies of this resolution in the manner and as provided in Section 56272 of the Government Code.



RESOLUTION NO. 69-45

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF MARIN APPROVING REORGANIZATION AND ORDERING SUCH REORGANIZATION

WHEREAS, this Board has heretofore adopted a resolution initiating proceedings for any reorganization consisting of the detachment of certain territory from the Tamalpais Community Services District and annexation of said territory to the Sausalito-Marín City Sanitary District, said proceedings being commenced by resolution submitted to the Local Agency Formation Commission by the Tamalpais Community Services District Resolution No. 8 and Sausalito-Marín City Sanitary District Resolution No. 274 proposing said reorganization, and

WHEREAS, a duly noticed public hearing on said reorganization was held on March 4, 1969, at 3:00 o'clock P.M., Board of Supervisors' Chambers, Civic Center, San Rafael, California, and

WHEREAS, testimony was taken at the hearing and objections were heard and considered by this Board on the question of such reorganization, and

WHEREAS, this Board has considered the resolution of the Local Agency Formation Commission making determinations on the reorganization, said resolution being numbered 69-3 and dated January 9, 1969;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board hereby finds, determines and orders as follows:

1. That the procedures heretofore followed for such resolution as required by law and notice of all hearings has been duly given in the manner provided by law.

2. The detachment of certain territory from the Tamalpais Community Services District and annexation of said territory to the Sausalito-Marín City Sanitary District is feasible, economically sound and for the public interest; and will be in the best interest of the County of Marin, the districts

affected and the inhabitants of said territory now and in the future.

3. All lands included in the proposed reorganization will be benefited thereby.

4. Said reorganization as above described is hereby ordered subject to no terms and conditions.

5. That there has been no majority protest to the reorganization as set forth in Section 56438 of the California Government Code and this Board hereby finds that the territory affected by the reorganization is uninhabited and, therefore, an election to confirm this Board's order is not required.

6. The boundaries of the property affected by the reorganization are as described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein.

7. That the Clerk of this Board be, and he is hereby, instructed to file a Certificate of Completion with all agencies as provided by law.



DEANNEXATION PARCEL
TAMALPAIS COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

BEGINNING AT THE POINT OF INTERSECTION OF THE SOUTHWESTERLY LINE OF LOT 25 BLOCK 191 AS SAID LOT AND BLOCK ARE DELINEATED ON THE MAP ENTITLED SECTION MAP G OF THE LANDS OF THE SAUSALITO LAND AND FERRY COMPANY DATED SEPTEMBER, 1888, AND RECORDED IN BOOK 3 OF MAPS AT PAGE 81, MARIN COUNTY RECORDS, WITH THE NORTHWESTERLY LINE OF MARIN CITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT UNIT FOUR AS THE MAP OF SAID PROJECT IS RECORDED IN BOOK 11 OF MAPS AT PAGE 46, MARIN COUNTY RECORDS, THENCE CONTINUING ALONG THE BOUNDARY OF SAID REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT NORTHERLY AND EASTERLY TO THE INTERSECTION OF SAID LINE WITH THE SOUTHWESTERLY LINE OF LOT 20, BLOCK 191 OF SAID SECTION MAP G, THENCE NORTHWESTERLY ALONG SAID SOUTHWESTERLY LINE TO THE NORTHWESTERN CORNER OF SAID LOT 20, THENCE NORTHEASTERLY ALONG THE NORTHWESTERLY LINE OF SAID LOT 20, BEING ALSO THE LINE COMMON TO LOT 21, TO THE POINT OF INTERSECTION WITH THE SOUTHWESTERLY RIGHT OF WAY OF SHORELINE HIGHWAY (STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE 1), THENCE NORTHWESTERLY AND WESTERLY AND SOUTHWESTERLY ALONG SAID LINE TO THE INTERSECTION WITH THE SOUTHWESTERLY LINE OF LOT 25 OF SAID BLOCK 191, THENCE SOUTH 38°-22' EAST ALONG SAID SOUTHWESTERLY LINE BEING ALSO THE LINE COMMON TO LOT 26 380 FEET, MORE OR LESS, TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.
