RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO  
SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 6

SIMMONS LANE ANNEX. 1969-10

WHEREAS, a resolution of application No. 1088 has been filed by  
Sanitary District No. 6, together with evidence of written  
consent of all owners of property within the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has found the territory to be annexed to be  
uninhabited; and

WHEREAS, the Sanitary District No. 6  
has not requested the Commission to hold a noticed public hearing in accordance  
with Government Code Section 56261.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Marin County Local Agency Forma-  
tion Commission, in accordance with the District Reorganization Act of 1965, that  
it does hereby approve the annexation of territory known as Simmons Lane Annex.  
1969-10 to Sanitary District No. 6  
with the following determinations:

1. Sanitary District No. 6 shall  
be the conducting District for further proceedings to annex this territory and  
the Board of Directors of that District is directed to initiate annexation pro-  
ceedings in compliance with this resolution and the resolution of application.  
Such proceedings may be without notice, without hearing, and without election.


2. The territory proposed for annexation shall be designated as  
Simmons Lane Annex. 1969-10.

EXHIBIT "A"

Beginning at a point on the existing boundary of Sanitary District No. 6 of Marin County, said point being on the Westerly line of Simmons Ln. at its intersection with the Northerly line of Lot 14 as said Ln. and Lot are shown upon that certain Map entitled, "Subdivision One, Sweetser Ranch, Novato, California", filed July 15, 1913 in Liber 4 of Maps at Page 49, Marin County Records; running thence from said point of beginning along said Sanitary District boundary and along said Westerly line of Simmons Ln. South  $29^{\circ} 11'$  West 43.39 feet; thence leaving said Westerly line of Simmons Ln. South  $60^{\circ} 49'$  East 50 feet to the Easterly line of said Simmons Ln.; thence leaving said Sanitary District boundary and running along said Easterly line of Simmons Ln. South  $29^{\circ} 11'$  West 60 feet to a point on said Sanitary District boundary; thence running along said Easterly line of Simmons Ln. and said Sanitary District boundary South  $29^{\circ} 11'$  West 16.84 feet; thence leaving said Easterly line of Simmons Ln. and continuing along said Sanitary District boundary North  $60^{\circ} 33'$  West 310 feet to a point on the Westerly line of said Lot 14; thence leaving said Sanitary District boundary and running along said Westerly line of Lot 14 North  $29^{\circ} 11'$  East 120 feet to the most Northerly corner of said Lot 14 and to a point on said Sanitary District boundary; thence running along said Sanitary District boundary and said Northerly line of Lot 14 South  $60^{\circ} 33'$  East 260 feet to the point of beginning.

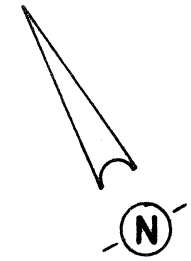
