RESOLUTION NO. 74-28

RESOLUTION MAKING DETERMINATIONS AND  
APPROVING THE FORMATION OF MARIN COUNTY  
SERVICE AREA NO. 19

WHEREAS, a proposal for the formation of a county service area for purposes of providing structural fire protection to certain unincorporated territories described in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein, located in the County of Marin, has been filed with the Executive Officer of this Commission; and

WHEREAS, said proposal was made in the form of Resolution No. 74-182 adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Marin, and requesting initiation of proceeding by this Commission upon said proposal pursuant to the Knox-Nisbet Act, Chapter 6.6 (commencing with Section 54773) of Division 2, Title 5 of the Government Code; and

WHEREAS, at the time and in the form and manner prescribed by law, the Executive Officer has given notice of public hearing by this Commission upon said proposal; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing on said proposal was held by this Commission upon the date and at the time specified in said notice of public hearing; and

WHEREAS, at said hearing this Commission received a request from the Marin County Board of Supervisors to amend its proposal to form County Service Area No. 19 to add additional territory thereto; and

WHEREAS, at said hearing this Commission heard and received all oral and written protests, objections and evidence made, presented or filed, including protests, objections and evidence upon the request to amend the original proposal.

NOW THEREFORE, the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Marin DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER as follows:

1. The proposal described in Resolution No. 74-182 adopted and submitted by the Marin County Board of Supervisors is hereby amended and modified to include certain additional territories hereinafter described.

2. Subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter specified, the proposal to form a county service area as amended and modified by this Commission is hereby approved.

3. The boundaries of the proposed county service area shall be those set forth in Exhibit B attached hereto and incorporated herein; and, said territory shall be designated as "County Service Area No. 19 of the County of Marin", and is found to be inhabited.

4. The proposal to form County Service Area No. 19 as amended and modified by this resolution is approved subject to the following terms and conditions:

- a. Prior to adoption of any resolution ordering formation of County Service Area No. 19 and calling an election thereon, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Marin shall execute and enter into a written agreement with the City Council of the City of San Rafael providing for secondary mutual aid fire protection response between the fire departments of the City of San Rafael and County Service Area No. 19, and prescribing the terms thereof.
- b. A ballot pamphlet containing an impartial analysis prepared by the Marin Local Agency Formation Commission and arguments for and against the proposed county service area shall be assembled and mailed by the County of Marin to each affected voter prior to the date of election on the formation proposition and/or proposed tax rate for said County Service Area No. 19.

5. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Marin is designated as the conducting body for further proceedings to form County Service Area No. 19; and is hereby authorized to initiate, conduct and complete said proceedings in compliance with the provisions of Chapter 2.2 (commencing with Section 25210.1) of Division 2, Title 3 of the Government Code, and the provisions of this resolution.


