RESOLUTION NO. 67-12

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO

SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 6:

VINEYARD ROAD ANNEXATION (1967-5)

WHEREAS, a resolution of application has been filed, together with evidence of written consent of all owners of property within the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has found the territory to be annexed to be uninhabited; and

WHEREAS, the Sanitary District No. 6 of the County of Marin has not requested the Commission to hold a noticed public hearing in accordance with Government Code Section 56261.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Marin County Local Agency Formation Commission, in accordance with the District Reorganization Act of 1965, that it does hereby approve the annexation of territory known as Vineyard Road Annexation (1967-5) to Sanitary District No. 6 of the County of Marin with the following determinations:

1. Sanitary District No. 6 of the County of Marin shall be the conducting District for further proceedings to annex this territory and the Board of Directors of that District is directed to initiate annexation proceedings in compliance with this resolution. Such proceedings may be without notice of hearing and without election.


2. The territory proposed for annexation shall be designated as Vineyard Road Annexation (1967-5).

VINEYARD ROAD ANNEX 1967-5

EXHIBIT "A"

BEGINNING at a point on the existing boundary of Sanitary District No. 6 of Marin County, said point being at the intersection of the Southerly line of Vineyard Road with the Westerly line of Davis Avenue (now Wild Horse Valley Drive) as shown upon that certain map entitled, "Amended Map No. 1 of Subdivision 'E' of the Novato Ranch, Marin County, Calif." filed July 6, 1910 in Book 3 of Maps at Page 54, Marin County Records; running thence from said point of beginning along said Sanitary District boundary and along said Westerly line of Davis Avenue (now Wild Horse Valley Drive) South $31^{\circ} 22' 48''$ East 468.63 feet to the most Easterly corner of Lot 14 as shown upon that certain map mentioned above; thence leaving said Westerly line of Davis Avenue (now Wild Horse Valley Drive) South $80^{\circ} 33' 36''$ West 487.48 feet to the most Southerly corner of said Lot 14; thence leaving said Sanitary District boundary North $10^{\circ} 23' 40''$ West 429.18 feet to a point on said Southerly line of Vineyard Road; thence along said Southerly line of Vineyard Road North $79^{\circ} 36' 20''$ East 319.68 feet to the point of beginning.
