RESOLUTION NO. 66-17

RESOLUTION ORDERING THE THREE "RESOLUTIONS PROPOSING THE FORMATION OF THE SOUTHERN MARIN SANITARY DISTRICT" TO A REORGANIZATION COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Marin County Local Agency Formation Commission has received from the Homestead Valley Sanitary District, the Almonte Sanitary District, and the Alto Sanitary District, substantially identical resolutions proposing the formation of the Southern Marin Sanitary District to include the territory of the three proposing districts plus Kay Park Sewer Maintenance District and the City of Mill Valley; said new sanitary district to be the successor to the four districts and to the City for provision of sanitary services; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Officer has reviewed these resolutions and found them to be permissive resolutions; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has reviewed said resolutions in accordance with Section 56212 of the Government Code; and

WHEREAS, after proper notice, the Commission has conducted a public hearing on the resolutions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the proposal of reorganization contained in the subject resolutions is referred to a Reorganization Committee; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the subject districts are: Almonte Sanitary District, Alto Sanitary District, Homestead Valley Sanitary District, Kay Park Sewer Maintenance District, and the City of Mill Valley.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the membership of the Committee shall not exceed one representative from each subject district.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the time and place of the first meeting of the Reorganization Committee shall be the Marin County Civic Center, Room 331, at 8:00 p.m., June 23, 1966.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Reorganization Committee shall, after study, report its recommendations to the Commission at the regular Commission meeting September 1, 1966 and that said study should include the following considerations:

1. The official position of the Mill Valley City Council in regard to this proposed reorganization.
 - a. If the Mill Valley City Council refuses to participate in the proposed new district, study the following: (1) The desirability of forming the district and (2) The wording and form of a contract between the City and the new district.
 - b. If the Mill Valley City Council agrees to participate, the matter of purchase of the Mill Valley Treatment Plant must be determined in detail.
2. The future of existing employees of the current districts must be specified.
3. The relationship of Kay Park Sewer Maintenance District to the proposed district must be considered.
4. The effective date of the new district must be specified.
5. The final boundaries with appropriate metes and bounds description should accompany the final committee report.


