RESOLUTION NO. 69-1

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO
SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 5

WEEKS ANNEXATION NO. 2 1968-1

WHEREAS, a resolution of application No. 68-10 has been filed by
Sanitary District No. 5, together with evidence of written
consent of all owners of property within the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has found the territory to be annexed to be
uninhabited; and

WHEREAS, the Sanitary District No. 5
has not requested the Commission to hold a noticed public hearing in accordance
with Government Code Section 56261.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Marin County Local Agency Forma-
tion Commission, in accordance with the District Reorganization Act of 1965, that
it does hereby approve the annexation of territory known as Weeks Annexation
No. 2 1968-1 to Sanitary District No. 5
with the following determinations:

1. Sanitary District No. 5 shall
be the conducting District for further proceedings to annex this territory and
the Board of Directors of that District is directed to initiate annexation pro-
ceedings in compliance with this resolution and the resolution of application.
Such proceedings may be without notice, without hearing, and without election.

2. The territory proposed for annexation shall be designated as
Weeks Annexation No. 2 1968-1.



ANNEXATION 1968-1

Beginning at a point on the Northerly line of Tiburon Boulevard, said point being the most Westerly corner of the lands of Raymond E. Weeks, and running thence along the Northwesterly line of Weeks and Parodi N. 34° 59' E. 450.000 feet to the most Northerly corner of the Weeks' Property, thence along the Northeasterly line of Weeks S. 55° 06' 30" E. 254.862 feet to the most Easterly corner thereof, thence along the Southeasterly line of Weeks and Williams S. 33° 33' W. 329.550 feet to most Southerly corner of the lands of Williams as conveyed by deed recorded in Book 1218 of Official Records at Page 191, and running thence along the exterior boundary of said Williams parcel N. 57° 58' 30" W. 100.000 ft. to the most Northerly corner of the lands of Lewis as conveyed by deed recorded in Book 1491 of official records at Page 041, and running thence along the Northwesterly line of the Lewis Parcel S. 33° 35' W. 107.385 feet to the before mentioned Northerly line of Tiburon Boulevard, thence along said line on a curve to the right whose center bears N. 29° 16' 39" E. and whose radius is 1700.000 feet through a central angle of 5° 35' 58" for a distance of 166.139 feet to the point of beginning.
