

RESOLUTION NO. 72-11

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 4

PARADISE CAY NO. 3 ANNEXATION

WHEREAS, by letter of application filed with the Executive Officer of this Commission, the owner of property within the area applied for annexation of certain territory to County Service Area No. 4; and

WHEREAS, at the time and in the form and manner provided by law, the Executive Officer has given notice of a public hearing by this Commission; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing by this Commission was held upon the date and at the time specified in said notice of public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Marin does hereby resolve, determine and order as follows:

1. The application for annexation of certain territory to County Service Area No. 4 is approved.
2. The territory proposed for annexation shall be designated as Paradise Cay No. 3 and is uninhabited.
3. The Marin County Board of Supervisors shall conduct further proceedings to annex this territory, and they are directed to initiate proceedings in compliance with this resolution.
