RESOLUTION NO. 73-26

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO
SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 2

BASH ANNEXATION

WHEREAS, a resolution of application No. 7-73 has been filed by Sanitary District No. 2 of Marin County together with evidence of written consent of all owners of property within the proposed annexation;

WHEREAS, the Commission has found the territory to be annexed to be uninhabited; and

WHEREAS, the Sanitary District No. 2 of Marin County has not requested the Commission to hold a public hearing in accordance with Government Code Section 56261;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Marin County Local Agency Formation Commission, in accordance with the District Reorganization Act of 1965, that it does hereby approve the annexation of territory known as Bash Annexation to Sanitary District No.2 of Marin County with the following determinations:

1. The annexation is subject to the terms and conditions contained in Sanitary District No. 2 of Marin County Resolution No. 7-73.
2. Sanitary District No. 2 shall be the conducting district for further proceedings to annex this territory and the Board of Directors of that District is directed to initiate annexation proceedings in compliance with this resolution and the resolution of application. Such proceedings may be without notice, without hearing, without election, and if an election is held, it shall only be held in the territory to be annexed.
3. The territory proposed for annexation shall be designated as Bash Annexation.

PARADISE COVE SUBDIVISION NO. 2 - IN AN UNINCORPORATED PORTION OF

THE COUNTY OF

MARIN

BEGINNING at a point on the Sanitary District No. Two boundary line, which point is the most westerly corner of lot 15 as said lot is delineated on that certain map entitled "Map of Paradise Cove, Subdivision No. Two, Marin County, California," as recorded on January 10, 1939 in Book 5 of Record Maps, at Page 77, Marin County Records, thence from said point of beginning along the boundary of said lot North 45° East 669.2 feet more or less to a point on the southerly line of Tide Lot No. 19, Sec. 24, T.1N., R. 5W., M.D.B. & M., thence along said southerly line South 183.847 feet, thence leaving said southerly line of said Tide Lot South 45° West 408 feet more or less, South $60^{\circ} 45'$ East 10.4 feet more or less, South 45° West 102 feet more or less to a point on the existing District boundary, thence along said Sanitary District No. Two boundary North $56^{\circ} 34'$ West 140.28 feet to the point of beginning.
