RESOLUTION NO. 71-22

RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THE FAILURE OF THE ALMONTE SANITARY
DISTRICT BOARD TO INITIATE PROCEEDINGS FOR THE
MILLER AVENUE DETACHMENT

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 4388 of the City of Mill Valley applying for detachment of certain territory from the Almonte Sanitary District was filed with the Executive Officer of this Commission; and

WHEREAS, at a public hearing on May 12, 1971, the Commission adopted Resolution No. 71-18 approving said detachment; and

WHEREAS, Commission Resolution No. 71-18 was delivered by certified mail to the Almonte Sanitary District on May 24, 1971; and

WHEREAS, by letter dated June 29, 1971, the Almonte Sanitary District Board has indicated its refusal to proceed with this detachment.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Marin does hereby certify as follows:

1. Thirty-five (35) days have expired from the date of adoption of the Commission's resolution approving the Miller Avenue Detachment from the Almonte Sanitary District.


