RESOLUTION NO. 66-10

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO:

SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 6:

ZECHLIN ANNEXATION (1966-2)

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WHEREAS, a resolution of application has been filed, together with evidence of written consent of all owners of property within the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has found the territory to be annexed to be uninhabited; and

WHEREAS, the Sanitary District No. 6 has not requested the Commission to hold a noticed public hearing in accordance with Government Code Section 56261.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Marin County Local Agency Formation Commission, in accordance with the District Reorganization Act of 1965, that it does hereby approve the annexation of territory known as Zechlin Annexation (1966-2) to Sanitary District No. 6 with the following determinations:

1. Sanitary District No. 6 shall be the conducting District for further proceedings to annex this territory and the Board of Directors of that District are directed to initiate annexation proceedings in compliance with this resolution. Such proceedings may be without notice of hearing and without election.


2. The territory proposed for annexation shall be designated as Zechlin Annexation (1966-2).

ZECHLIN ANNEX 1966-2

EXHIBIT "A"

BEGINNING at a point on the existing boundary of Sanitary District No. 6 of Marin County, said point being at the intersection of the Easterly line of Simmons Lane and the Southerly line of Virginia Avenue as said Lane and Avenue are shown upon that certain map entitled, "Subdivision One, Sweetser Ranch, Novato, Calif.", filed July 15, 1913 in Liber 4 of Maps at Page 49, Marin County Records; running thence along said Sanitary District boundary and along said Southerly line of Virginia Avenue, South 60° 49' East 125 feet to the true point of beginning; thence leaving said Sanitary District boundary and said Southerly line of Virginia Avenue South 29° 11' West 120 feet; thence South 60° 49' East 57.5 feet; thence North 29° 11' East 120 feet to said Sanitary District boundary and to said Southerly line of Virginia Avenue; thence along said Sanitary District boundary and said Southerly line of Virginia Avenue North 60° 49' West 57.5 feet to the true point of beginning.
