RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO
SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 6

PIONEER MEMORIAL PARK ANNEX 1968-7

WHEREAS, Sanitary District No. 6 of Marin County Resolution No. 1035, a resolution of application to annex certain territory, has been filed with the Executive Officer of this Commission; and

WHEREAS, at the time and in the form and manner provided by law the Executive Officer has given notice of a public hearing by this Commission upon said resolution; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing by this Commission was held upon the date and at the time specified in said notice of public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Marin does hereby resolve, determine, and order as follows:

1. Sanitary District No. 6 of Marin County Resolution No. 1035 is approved subject to the terms and conditions contained therein.
2. The territory proposed for annexation shall be designated as the Pioneer Memorial Park Annexation and is uninhabited.
3. Sanitary District No. 6 shall be the conducting district for further proceedings to annex this territory and the Board of Directors of that district is directed to initiate proceedings in compliance with this resolution and the resolution of application, and if any election is ordered, it shall be held only in the territory to be annexed.
4. The Executive Officer is hereby authorized and directed to mail certified copies of this resolution in the manner and as provided in Section 56272 of the Government Code.

PIONEER MEMORIAL PARK ANNEX 1968-7

EXHIBIT "A"

BEGINNING at a point on the existing boundary of Sanitary District No. 6 of Marin County, California, said point being on the Northwesterly line of Simmons Lane at its intersection with the Southerly line of Lot 16 as shown upon that certain map entitled "Subdivision One, Sweetser Ranch, Novato, California", filed July 15, 1913 in Liber 4 of Maps at Page 49, Marin County Records; thence running along said Sanitary District boundary and along said Northwesterly line of Simmons Lane North 29° 11' East 139.91 feet; thence leaving said Northwesterly line of Simmons Lane and continuing along said Sanitary District boundary North 55° 20' West 584.72 feet; thence North 38° 16' East 255 feet, more or less, to a point on the Northerly line of said Lot 16, said Northerly line of Lot 16 also being the centerline of the Arroyo De Novato; thence Westerly along said Northerly line of Lot 16 and along said centerline of the Arroyo De Novato to the most Northerly corner of said Lot 16; thence leaving said centerline of the Arroyo De Novato and running along the Northwesterly and Southwesterly lines of said Lot 16 South 22° 40' West 24.3 feet; thence South 54° 44' West 40.0 feet; thence South 30° 36' East 451.0 feet; thence South 30° 37' West 277.482 feet; thence South 60° 33' East 193.10'; thence leaving said Sanitary District boundary South 60° 33' East 360.0 feet to a point on said Sanitary District boundary, said point also being a point on said Northwesterly line of Simmons Lane; thence along said Sanitary District boundary and said Northwesterly line of Simmons Lane North 29° 11' East 217', more or less, to the point of beginning.
