RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO
SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 2

MUNDEN ANNEXATION 1971-2

WHEREAS, a resolution of application No. 20-71 has been filed by
Sanitary District No. 2, together with evidence of written
consent of all owners of property within the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has found the territory to be annexed to be
uninhabited; and

WHEREAS, the Sanitary District No. 2
has not requested the Commission to hold a noticed public hearing in accordance
with Government Code Section 56261.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Marin County Local Agency Forma-
tion Commission, in accordance with the District Reorganization Act of 1965, that
it does hereby approve the annexation of territory known as Munden Annexation
1971-2 to Sanitary District No. 2
with the following determinations:

1. Sanitary District No. 2 shall
be the conducting District for further proceedings to annex this territory and
the Board of Directors of that District is directed to initiate annexation pro-
ceedings in compliance with this resolution and the resolution of application.
Such proceedings may be without notice, without hearing, and without election.


2. The territory proposed for annexation shall be designated as
Munden Annexation 1971-2.

EXHIBIT A

RICHARD D. MUNDEN ANNEXATION 1971-2

TO

SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 2 OF MARIN COUNTY

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

All that certain real property situated in the County of Marin, State of California, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the most Southwesterly corner of Lot 19, as shown upon that certain map entitled "Map of Paradise Cove, Marin County, California", filed for record January 10, 1939 in Volume 5 of Maps, at Page 77, Marin County Records; thence leaving existing Sanitary District No. 2 boundary line and running North $45^{\circ} 00'$ East, 546.593 feet to the Northerly line of said lot; thence East, 98.995 feet to the most Easterly corner of said lot; thence South $45^{\circ} 00'$ West, 350.26 feet; South $41^{\circ} 27'$ East, 10.018 feet, more or less; thence South $45^{\circ} 00'$ West, 275.37 feet to a point on the existing District boundary; thence along said Sanitary District boundary North $38^{\circ} 07'$ West, 80.58 feet to the point of beginning.
