

RESOLUTION 95-9

RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE MARIN LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION
COMMISSION AMENDING THE SPHERE OF INFLUENCE FOR THE
RICHARDSON BAY SANITARY DISTRICT

"Tiburon Blvd. Annexation"

WHEREAS, one of the purposes of a Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) is to establish and maintain sphere of influence boundaries for local agencies; and

WHEREAS, on June 7, 1983, the Marin Local Agency Formation Commission adopted a Sphere of Influence Report and boundary for the Richardson Bay Sanitary District; and

WHEREAS, LAFCO law provides for amendments to an established sphere of influence resulting from a filed written request by an individual or local agency, and

WHEREAS, LAFCO law further provides that the Commission may approve or disapprove with or without amendment, wholly, partially, or conditionally, the request; and

WHEREAS, the property owners have requested to amend Richardson Bay Sanitary District Sphere of Influence boundary in order to provide sanitary sewer service to three parcels, to rebuild an existing single family home and second unit as necessary due to fire damage; and to correct illogical service boundary for eventual abandonment of septic systems when necessary; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was held on October 5, 1993, regarding the amendment to the Richardson Bay Sanitary District Sphere of Influence boundary, at which time LAFCO received testimony and also considered, (1) the Executive Officer's Report and Recommendation, (2) state mandated criteria, (3) Marin LAFCO "Adopted Policy Guidelines," and other matters relevant to the local program.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

Section 1. The Marin Local Agency Formation Commission does hereby amend the Richardson Bay Sanitary District Sphere of Influence boundary to include AP Nos. 055-252-01, 02 & 06.

Section 2. The location of said boundaries is shown on an attached map and incorporated herein.


Section 3. The proposal is Categorically Exempt pursuant to provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act.


