RESOLUTION NO. 74-29

RESOLUTION MAKING DETERMINATIONS AND
DENYING THE FORMATION OF MARIN COUNTY
SERVICE AREA NO. 20

WHEREAS, a proposal for the formation of a county service area for purposes of providing structural fire protection to certain unincorporated territories described in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein, located in the County of Marin, has been filed with the Executive Officer of this Commission; and

WHEREAS, said proposal was made in the form of Resolution No. 74-183 adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Marin, and requesting initiation of proceeding by this Commission upon said proposal pursuant to the Knox-Nisbet Act, Chapter 6.6(commencing with Section 54773) of Division 2, Title 5 of the Government Code; and

WHEREAS, at the time and in the form and manner prescribed by law, the Executive Officer has given notice of public hearing by this Commission upon said proposal; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing on said proposal was held by this Commission upon the date and at the time specified in said notice of public hearing; and

WHEREAS, at said hearing this Commission heard and received all oral and written protests, objections and evidence made, presented or filed,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Marin DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER as follows:

1. The proposal to form a county service area made by Resolution No. 74-183 of the Board of Supervisors of Marin County is hereby denied.


2. The proposal is denied by reason of inclusion of the territory described therein in a proposal to form County Service Area No. 19 for the same purposes.
