RESOLUTION NO. 99-5

**RESOLUTION MAKING DETERMINATIONS AND APPROVING CONSOLIDATION OF THE TAMALPAIS FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AND ALTO-RICHARDSON BAY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT SUBJECT TO NOTICE AND HEARING REQUIREMENTS, BUT WITHOUT ELECTION, TO FORM A SINGLE NEW FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AS THE:**

**"Southern Marin Fire Protection District"**

**WHEREAS**, substantially identical resolutions proposing the consolidation of the Tamalpais Fire Protection District and the Alto-Richardson Bay Fire Protection District to form a new single fire protection district in the County of Marin has been filed with the Acting Executive Officer of this Commission pursuant to Title 5, Division 3, commencing with Section 56000 of the Government Code; and

**WHEREAS**, said proposal was made in the form of Tamalpais Fire Protection District Board of Directors Resolution #98-99-7 and Alto-Richardson Bay Fire Protection District Board of Directors Resolution # 99-1, filed by the Tamalpais Fire Protection District Board of Directors and Alto-Richardson Bay Fire Protection District Board of Directors; and

**WHEREAS**, at the time and in the form and manner prescribed by law, the Acting Executive Officer has given notice of public hearing by this Commission upon said proposal; and

**WHEREAS**, the public hearing on said proposal was held by this Commission upon the date and at the time and place specified in said notice of public hearing, and all interested persons present were afforded an opportunity to speak and be heard on the matter; and

**WHEREAS**, the Acting Executive Officer has reviewed the proposal and prepared a report, including recommendation thereon, the proposal and report having been presented to and considered by this Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tamalpais Fire Protection District Board of Directors and the Alto-Richardson Bay Fire Protection District Board of Directors, as lead agency, have determined that the proposed consolidation is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act under State Resources Code Section 15320 Class 20(b).

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Marin **DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER** as follows:

Section 1. Subject to terms and conditions hereinafter specified, the proposals made in the Tamalpais Fire Protection District Board of Directors Resolution #98-99-7 and Alto-

Richardson Bay Fire Protection District Board of Directors Resolution # 99-1, and adopted by the Tamalpais Fire Protection District Board of Directors and Alto-Richardson Bay Fire Protection District Board of Directors, are approved.

Section 2. The boundaries, as set forth in the proposal and described in Exhibit "A" and Exhibit "B" attached hereto, are hereby approved and by this reference incorporated herein.

Section 3. The affected territory includes 3,422 acres, is found to be inhabited, and is assigned the following short form designation: "Southern Marin Fire Protection District" formed by the consolidation of the Tamalpais Fire Protection District and the Alto-Richardson Bay Fire Protection District.

Section 4. The proposal is consistent with Tamalpais Fire Protection District and Alto-Richardson Bay Fire Protection District spheres of influence.

Section 5. Any resolution ordering the consolidation approved by this resolution shall impose the following terms and conditions:

1. The effective date of the consolidation should be July 1, 1999 or as soon as legally possible thereafter under applicable State law.
2. All existing laws, ordinances, resolutions, actions, contracts, agreements, rules and regulations, policies and procedures, that have been enacted, adopted or passed by either district prior to the effective date of the consolidation shall remain in effect after the consolidation until superseded, amended, modified or deleted by the Board of Directors of the single new district. Any conflict in the application of the aforementioned issues that arise after the consolidation shall be resolved at the discretion of the Board of Directors of the single new district.
3. All decisions or actions affecting the proposed consolidation and made prior to the effective date of the consolidation shall require the majority approval of the directors of both fire districts.
4. The new district shall be governed by a seven (7) member board, with directors being elected at large.
5. The Marin County Board of Supervisors, as the conducting authority, shall appoint the initial seven (7) members of the governing board as provided for in the resolutions of application adopted by the Alto-Richardson Bay Fire Protection District and the Tamalpais Fire Protection District.
6. The name of the new single district shall be the Southern Marin Fire Protection District.

7. The appropriations limit of the new single district for Fiscal Year 1999/2000 shall be the combined total of the Alto-Richardson Bay Fire Protection District and the Tamalpais Fire Protection District.
8. After consolidation, the existing debt service on the headquarters fire station and fire engine of the Alto-Richardson Bay Fire Protection District will continue to be serviced by only those property owners who were within the Alto-Richardson Bay Fire Protection District prior to consolidation.
9. The Sphere of Influence of the new single district shall be the combined Spheres of Influence of the two former districts.

Section 6. The Findings set forth in the Acting Executive Officers Report on the proposed consolidation dated April 2, 1999 are incorporated into this resolution by reference.

Section 7. The project is categorically exempt pursuant to §15320 Class 20(b) of the Guidelines for Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act.

Section 8. The Marin County Board of Supervisors is designated as the conducting authority for further proceedings, and the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to initiate proceedings in compliance with this Resolution, and is authorized to take further proceedings upon said consolidation in compliance with applicable provisions of State law.


Section 9. The Acting Executive Officer is hereby authorized and directed to mail certified copies of the resolution in the manner prescribed by Section 56853 of the Government Code.



along the easterly boundary line of said Sausalito Canal, North 37°30' West 523 feet more or less to a point, said point being on the Mill Valley Corporate Limits; thence, leaving said easterly boundary line of the Sausalito Canal, northerly and westerly along said Mill Valley Corporate Limits to the **Point of Beginning**.

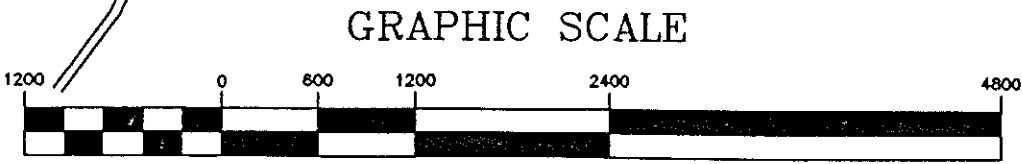

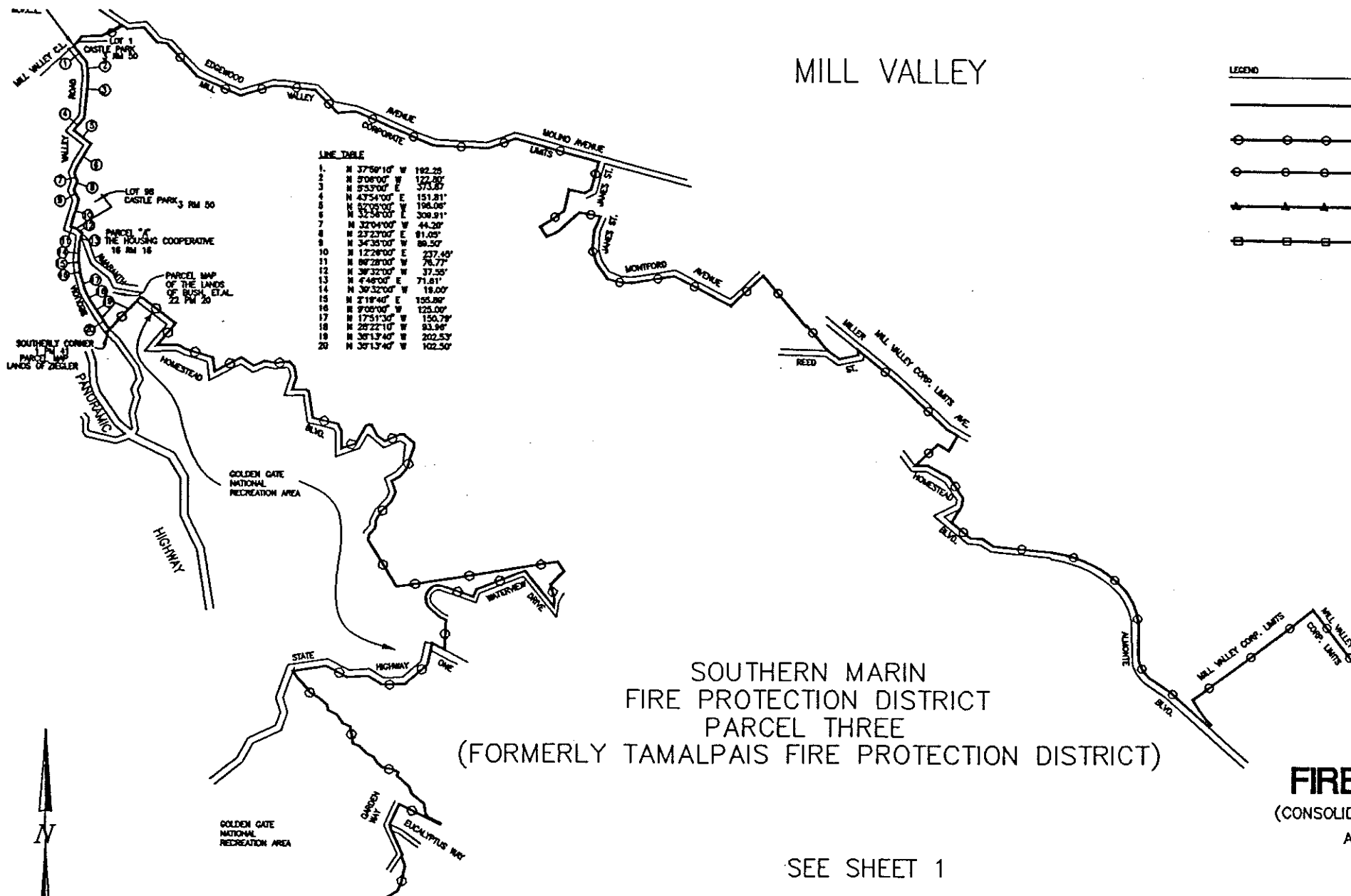

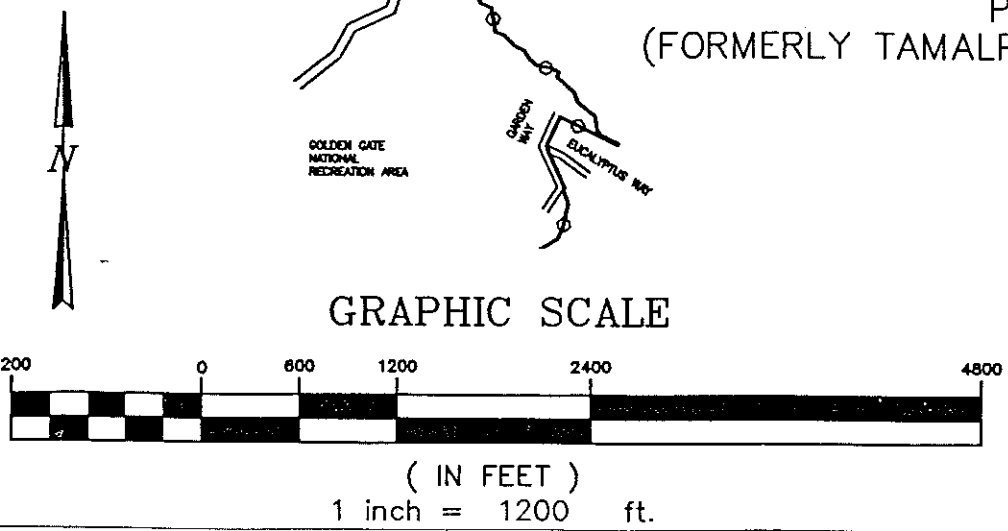

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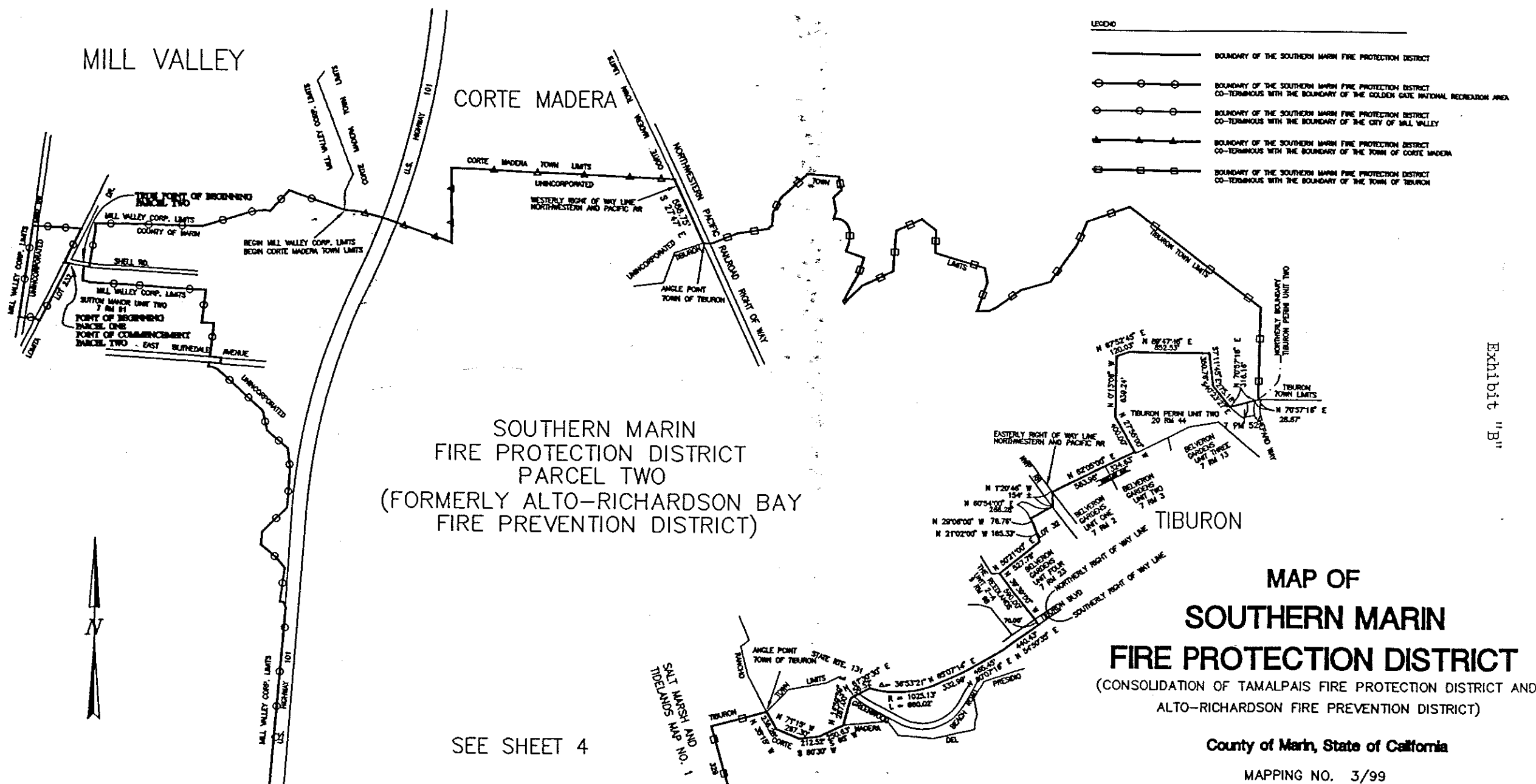

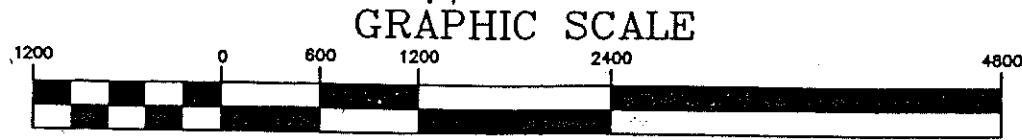

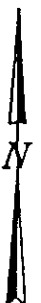
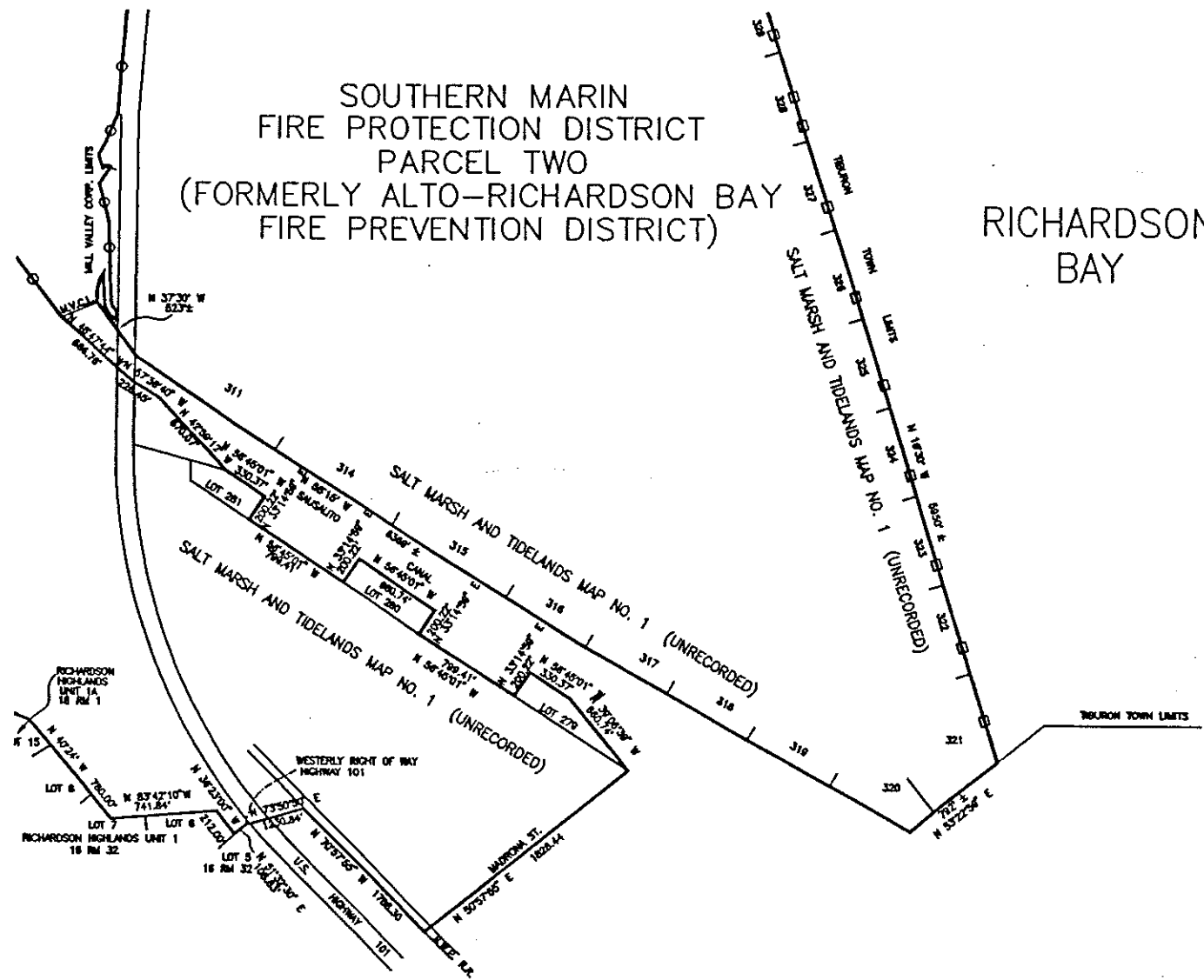
