RESOLUTION NO. 75-2

RESOLUTION MAKING DETERMINATIONS AND DENYING THE DETACHMENT DESIGNATED AS "HAMILTON AIR FORCE BASE-RAFAEL VILLAGE MILITARY HOUSING COMPLEX" DETACHMENT FROM THE NOVATO FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, a proposal for the detachment of certain territory from the Novato Fire Protection District has been filed with the Executive Officer of this Commission;

and

WHEREAS, said proposal was made in the form of Resolution No. 74-2, a resolution of application, adopted by the Board of Directors of the Novato Fire Protection District, and requested initiation of detachment proceedings in accordance with the provisions of the District Reorganization Act of 1965, Division 1 (commencing with Section 56000), of Title 6 of the Government Code;

and

WHEREAS, at the time and in the form and manner prescribed by law, the Executive Officer has given notice of public hearing by this Commission on said proposal;

and

WHEREAS, the public hearing on said proposal was held by this Commission upon the date and at the time specified in said notice of public hearing;

and

WHEREAS, at said hearing, this Commission heard and received all oral and written protests, objections and evidence for and against the proposal made, presented or filed,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Marin DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER as follows:

1. The proposal, made by Resolution No. 74-2 of the Board of Directors of the Novato Fire Protection District, to detach that area designated as "Hamilton Air Force Base-Rafael Village Military Housing Complex" Detachment is hereby denied.

2. The proposal is denied for the following reasons:

This Commission is aware that further information is forthcoming regarding the future use and disposition of the Federal lands located at Hamilton Air Force Base. Such information is requisite to the Commission's careful and thoughtful consideration and determination relative to the sub-


stantial issues raised by the detachment proposal. Because, however, it could take 90 days or longer for all information to be brought forth, and in recognition of the time limitations imposed upon this Commission by State Laws, the Commission is denying the proposal at this time in order to await the forthcoming information. Accordingly, the denial is made without prejudice toward a refileing of the proposal at such time as information regarding future use and disposition of the affected Federal lands is available.
