RESOLUTION NO. 69-33

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF TERRITORY FROM THE  
CITY OF BELVEDERE TO THE CITY OF TIBURON

ZELINSKY TRANSFER

WHEREAS, application by the City of Tiburon dated July 25, 1969 for a property transfer from the City of Belvedere has been filed with the Executive Officer of this Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City of Belvedere Resolution No. 1325, a resolution consenting to the transfer has been filed with the Executive Officer of this Commission; and

WHEREAS, the owner of the territory has in writing, expressed his desire that such transfer be effected; and

WHEREAS, at the time and in the form and manner provided by law, the Executive Officer has given notice of a public hearing by this Commission upon said application; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing by this Commission was held upon the date and at the time specified in said notice of public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Marin does hereby resolve, determine, and order as follows:

1. The City of Tiburon application for property transfer dated July 25, 1969 is approved.
2. This transfer shall be designated as the Zelinsky Transfer and is uninhabited.
3. The City of Tiburon is hereby authorized to initiate proceedings for transfer of the property.
4. The Marin County Board of Supervisors shall be the governing body for further proceedings.



DESCRIPTION OF LANDS TO BE ANNEXED TO

THE CITY OF TIBURON

Beginning at Tide Land Station 438 as shown on Allardt's 1870 unrecorded Map No. 1 of the Salt Marsh and Tide Lands, Marin County, California, thence along the survey line between Tide Land Stations 438 and 437 as shown on said Map N 60°09'10" W (Deed N 60°15' W) 326 feet more or less to the southwesterly line of California State Highway Marin 131, formerly Road IV Marin 52-A, thence southeasterly along said southwesterly line S 26°01'40" E 57.09 feet, thence on a curve to the left having a radius of 1,050 feet a distance of 508.85 feet, thence S 53°56'40" E 470 feet more or less to a point which bears N 25° 36' W 465 feet more or less from Tide Land Station 381 as shown on said Map, thence leaving said southwesterly line of the Highway N 25°36' W 450 feet more or less to a point which bears S 65°44'10" E (Deed S 66° E) 295 feet from said Tide Land Station 438, thence N 65°44'10" W 295 feet more or less to the Point of Beginning.
