RESOLUTION NO. 66-33

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO

LAS GALLINAS VALLEY SANITARY DISTRICT:

SANTA MARGARITA VALLEY PARK ANNEXATION (1966-2)

WHEREAS, a resolution of application has been filed, together with evidence of written consent of all owners of property within the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has found the territory to be annexed to be uninhabited; and

WHEREAS, the Las Gallinas Valley Sanitary District has not requested the Commission to hold a noticed public hearing in accordance with Government Code Section 56261.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Marin County Local Agency Formation Commission, in accordance with the District Reorganization Act of 1965, that it does hereby approve the annexation of territory known as Santa Margarita Valley Park Annexation (1966-2) to Las Gallinas Valley Sanitary District with the following determinations:

1. Las Gallinas Valley Sanitary District

shall be the conducting District for further proceedings to annex this territory and the Board of Directors of that District is directed to initiate annexation proceedings in compliance with this resolution. Such proceedings may be without notice of hearing and without election.


2. The territory proposed for annexation shall be designated as Santa Margarita Valley Park Annexation (1966-2).

Annex 1966-2, Santa Margarita Valley Park

Description:

Beginning at a point in the existing boundary of the Las Gallinas Valley Sanitary District, said point being the Northwest corner of Lot 123 as shown on that certain Map entitled "Terra Linda Valley No. 4" recorded June 23, 1960 in Volume 10 of Maps at page 64, Marin County Records; running thence from said point of beginning and leaving said existing District boundary North $86^{\circ} 57' 36''$ West 103.90 feet; thence South $58^{\circ} 15' 46''$ West 116.99 feet; thence South $36^{\circ} 30'$ East 210.0 feet; thence South $53^{\circ} 30'$ West 105.0 feet; thence, on a curve to the right with a radius of 400.0 feet through an angle of $17^{\circ} 30'$ for a distance of 122.17 feet; thence South $12^{\circ} 18' 32''$ East 321.03 feet; thence South $61^{\circ} 18' 32''$ East 248.29 feet; thence North $44^{\circ} 11' 28''$ East 392.15 feet to a point in the existing boundary of the Las Gallinas Valley Sanitary District; thence along said existing District boundary North $32^{\circ} 00'$ West 66.57 feet; thence North $6^{\circ} 00'$ East 189.79 feet; thence North $89^{\circ} 00'$ West 52.62 feet; thence South $80^{\circ} 00'$ West 150.00 feet; thence North $10^{\circ} 00'$ West 164.11 feet; thence North $21^{\circ} 30'$ West 122.46 feet to the point of beginning.
