RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO
SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 6

TAMALPAIS AVENUE ANNEX 1969-4

WHEREAS, a resolution of application No. 1061 has been filed by
Sanitary District No. 6, together with evidence of written
consent of all owners of property within the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has found the territory to be annexed to be
uninhabited; and

WHEREAS, the Sanitary District No. 6
has not requested the Commission to hold a noticed public hearing in accordance
with Government Code Section 56261.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Marin County Local Agency Forma-
tion Commission, in accordance with the District Reorganization Act of 1965, that
it does hereby approve the annexation of territory known as _____
Tamalpais Avenue Annex 1969-4 to Sanitary District No. 6
_____ with the following determinations:

1. Sanitary District No. 6 shall
be the conducting District for further proceedings to annex this territory and
the Board of Directors of that District is directed to initiate annexation pro-
ceedings in compliance with this resolution and the resolution of application.
Such proceedings may be without notice, without hearing, and without election.

2. The territory proposed for annexation shall be designated as
Tamalpais Avenue Annex 1969-4.

TAMALPAIS AVENUE ANNEX 1969-4

"EXHIBIT A"

BEGINNING at a point on the existing boundary of Sanitary District No. 6 of Marin County, said point being on the Northwesterly line of Lot 1, distant thereon North $29^{\circ} 11'$ East 20.00 feet from its intersection with the Northeasterly line of Novato Boulevard as said Lot and Boulevard are shown upon that certain map entitled "Subdivision One, Sweetser Ranch, Novato, California", filed July 15, 1913 in Liber 4 of maps at page 49, Marin County Records, said point also being on the Easterly line of Tamalpais Avenue; thence leaving said Northwesterly line of Lot 1 and running along said Sanitary District boundary and along said Easterly line of Tamalpais Avenue North $60^{\circ} 49'$ West 8.00 feet; thence on a curve tangent to the preceding course, concave to the Northeast, having a radius of 20 feet, through a central angle of $90^{\circ} 00'$, a distance of 31.42 feet; thence North $29^{\circ} 11'$ East 163.73 feet; thence along a curve tangent to the preceding course, concave to the West, having a radius of 642.0 feet, through a central angle of $30^{\circ} 37' 24''$, a distance of 343.13 feet; thence North $1^{\circ} 26' 24''$ West 178.91 feet; thence leaving said Easterly line of Tamalpais Avenue and continuing along said Sanitary District boundary South $81^{\circ} 49'$ East 315.21 feet to a point on the Easterly line of Lot 27 as said Lot is shown upon that certain map hereinabove mentioned; thence along the Easterly line of said Lot 27 and said Lot 1 South $8^{\circ} 09'$ West 564 feet; thence leaving said Sanitary District boundary and said Easterly line of Lot 1 South $71^{\circ} 29'$ West 69.28 feet; thence North $56^{\circ} 20'$ West 237 feet to a point on said Northwesterly line of Lot 1; thence running along said Northwesterly line South $29^{\circ} 11'$ West 228 feet to the point of beginning.
