RESOLUTION NO. 68-10

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO

SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 6:

TRUMBULL AVENUE ANNEXATION (1967-9)

---

WHEREAS, Sanitary District No. 6 of Marin County Resolution No. 963, a resolution of application to annex certain territory, has been filed with the Executive Officer; and

WHEREAS, at the times and in the form and manner provided by law the Executive Officer has given notice of a public hearing by this Commission on said resolution; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing by this Commission was opened upon the date and at the time specified in said resolution of public hearing and was continued to March 7, 1968.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION OF THE COUNTY OF MARIN DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER as follows:

1. Resolution No. 963 of Sanitary District No. 6 is approved subject to the terms and conditions contained therein and on condition that proceedings for annexation of the same territory to the City of Novato are completed on or before September 7, 1968.

2. The territory proposed for annexation shall be designated as Trumbull Avenue Annexation (1967-9).

3. Sanitary District No. 6 shall be the conducting district for further proceedings to annex this territory and the Board of Directors of that District is directed to initiate annexation proceedings in compliance with this resolution, and if any election is ordered it shall be held only in the territory to be annexed.

4. The resolution of the conducting district ordering such annexation shall provide that the annexation shall be subject to the same terms and conditions as are contained in the resolution of application (Resolution No. 963) of Sanitary District No. 6 and as are contained herein.

EXHIBIT "A"

BEGINNING at a point on the existing boundary of Sanitary District No. 6 of Marin County, California, said point being on the Southeasterly line of Trumbull Avenue, distant thereon South 29° 15' West 1,490.0 feet from its intersection with the Southerly line of Mill Road as shown upon that certain map entitled, "Amended Map No. 1 of Subdivision 'C' of the Novato Ranch, Marin County, Calif.", filed July 6, 1910 in Book 3 of Maps at Page 53, Marin County Records; thence leaving said Sanitary District Boundary and running along said Southeasterly line of Trumbull Avenue South 29° 15' 00" West 505.00 feet; thence leaving said Southeasterly line of Trumbull Avenue North 60° 45'00" West 175.00 feet; thence North 15° 40'00" East 428.00 feet; thence North 55° 00'00" West 218.00 feet; thence South 40° 39' 00" West 392.00 feet; thence South 76° 00'00" West 698.00 feet; thence South 54° 18'00" West 385.00 feet; thence North 35° 25'00" West 630.00 feet, more or less, to a point on the Westerly boundary of Lot 269 as shown upon that certain map entitled, "Map of Subdivision 'F' of the Novato Ranch, Marin County, Calif.", filed July 6, 1910 in Book 3 of Maps at page 55, Marin County Records; thence along said Westerly line of Lot 269 North 8° 44'24" East 630.00 feet, more or less to a point on said Sanitary District boundary; thence leaving said Westerly line of Lot 269 and running along said Sanitary District boundary South 81° 15'36" East 904.35 feet; thence North 18° 15' East 132.0 feet; thence South 71° 45' East 930.0 feet; thence South 29° 15' West 225.0 feet; thence South 60° 45' East 245.0 feet to the point of beginning.
