RESOLUTION NO. 66-26

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO

SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 6:

SIEVE ANNEXATION (1966-9)

WHEREAS, a resolution of application has been filed, together with evidence of written consent of all owners of property within the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has found the territory to be annexed to be uninhabited; and

WHEREAS, the Sanitary District No. 6 has not requested the Commission to hold a noticed public hearing in accordance with Government Code Section 56261.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Marin County Local Agency Formation Commission, in accordance with the District Reorganization Act of 1965, that it does hereby approve the annexation of territory known as Sieve Annexation (1966-9) to Sanitary District No. 6 with the following determinations:

1. Sanitary District No. 6 shall be the conducting District for further proceedings to annex this territory and the Board of Directors of that District is directed to initiate annexation proceedings in compliance with this resolution. Such proceedings may be without notice of hearing and without election.


2. The territory proposed for annexation shall be designated as Sieve Annexation (1966-9).



SIEVE ANNEX 1966-9

Exhibit "A"

BEGINNING at a point on the existing boundary of Sanitary District No. 6 of Marin County, California, said point being at the intersection of the Southerly line of Novato Boulevard with the Easterly line of Lot 48 as shown on that certain map entitled, "Map of Subdivisions A and B of the Novato Ranch, Marin County, California", filed November 18, 1909 in Book 3 of Maps at Page 36, Marin County Records; running thence from said point of beginning along said Sanitary District boundary and along said Easterly line of Lot 48 South $29^{\circ} 15'$ West 170.0 feet; thence leaving said Easterly line of Lot 48 North $60^{\circ} 45'$ West 68.5 feet; thence leaving said Sanitary District boundary North $29^{\circ} 15'$ East 170.0 feet to a point on said Sanitary District boundary and on said Southerly line of Novato Boulevard; running thence along said Sanitary District boundary and along said Southerly line of Novato Boulevard South $60^{\circ} 45'$ East 68.5 feet to the point of beginning.
