RESOLUTION NO. 67-4

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO

SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 6:

NOVATO AUTO MART ANNEXATION (1967-1)

WHEREAS, a resolution of application has been filed, together with evidence of written consent of all owners of property within the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has found the territory to be annexed to be uninhabited; and

WHEREAS, the Sanitary District No. 6 of the County of Marin has not requested the Commission to hold a noticed public hearing in accordance with Government Code Section 56261.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Marin County Local Agency Formation Commission, in accordance with the District Reorganization Act of 1965, that it does hereby approve the annexation of territory known as Novato Auto Mart Annexation (1967-1) to Sanitary District No. 6 of the County of Marin with the following determinations:

1. Sanitary District No. 6 of the County of Marin shall be the conducting District for further proceedings to annex this territory and the Board of Directors of that District is directed to initiate annexation proceedings in compliance with this resolution. Such proceedings may be without notice of hearing and without election.


2. The territory proposed for annexation shall be designated as Novato Auto Mart Annexation (1967-1).

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Marin County Local Agency Formation Commission on this 2nd day of March, 1967 by the following vote:



NOVATO AUTO MART ANNEX 1967-1

"EXHIBIT A"

BEGINNING at a point on the existing boundary of Sanitary District No. 6 of Marin County, said point being on the Northerly line of Yukon Way distant South $82^{\circ} 56' 10''$ West 77.457 feet from the most Southeasterly corner of Lot M as shown upon that certain map entitled, "Record of Survey of Marin Fur Village, Novato, Calif." filed October 25, 1949 in Volume 2 of Surveys at Page 147, Marin County Records; thence leaving said Northerly line of Yukon Way and running along said Sanitary District boundary North $6^{\circ} 30'$ West 100.14 feet; thence North $73^{\circ} 23' 50''$ West 152.296 feet; thence North $32^{\circ} 20' 20''$ East 56.969 feet; thence North $54^{\circ} 40'$ West 216.0 feet; thence North $48^{\circ} 27'$ West 127.0 feet; thence North $55^{\circ} 17'$ West 174.803 feet; thence North $74^{\circ} 49'$ West 84.19 feet; thence South $72^{\circ} 00'$ West 30.773 feet; thence leaving said Sanitary District boundary North $00^{\circ} 35'$ East 83.497 feet; thence on a curve to the left having a radius of 80 feet, whose center bears North $12^{\circ} 28' 19''$ West, through a central angle of $77^{\circ} 25' 41''$, an arc distance of 108.11 feet; thence North $00^{\circ} 06'$ East 105 feet; thence North $49^{\circ} 22'$ East 530.821 feet to the Southwesterly line of the California State Highway 101; thence along said Southwesterly line South $40^{\circ} 38'$ East 830.04 feet; thence leaving said Southwesterly line South $49^{\circ} 22'$ West 241.03 feet; thence South $7^{\circ} 03'$ East 313.92 feet to a point on said Northerly line of Yukon Way; thence along said Northerly line South $82^{\circ} 56' 10''$ West 212.03 feet to the point of beginning.
