RESOLUTION NO. 66-1

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO:

SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 6:

DIAS ANNEXATION (1965-8)

WHEREAS, a resolution of application has been filed, together with evidence of written consent of all owners of property within the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has found the territory to be annexed to be uninhabited; and

WHEREAS, the Sanitary District No. 6 has not requested the Commission to hold a noticed public hearing in accordance with Government Code Section 56261.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Marin County Local Agency Formation Commission, in accordance with the District Reorganization Act of 1965, that it does hereby approve the annexation of territory known as the Dias Annexation (1965-8) to Sanitary District No. 6 with the following determinations:

1. Sanitary District No. 6 shall be the conducting District for further proceedings to annex this territory and the Board of Directors of that District are directed to initiate annexation proceedings in compliance with this resolution. Such proceedings may be without notice of hearing and without election.


2. The territory proposed for annexation shall be designated as the Dias Annexation (1965-8).

DIAS ANNEX 1965-8

EXHIBIT "A"

BEGINNING at a point on the existing boundary of Sanitary District No. 6 of Marin County, said point being on the centerline of Diablo Avenue at the common corner of Lots 96, 97, 66 and 65 as shown on that certain map entitled "Map of Subdivisions A and B of the Novato Ranch, Marin County, California", filed November 18, 1909 in Book 3 of Maps at Page 36, Marin County Records; thence leaving said Sanitary District boundary and running along said centerline of Diablo Avenue South $29^{\circ} 15'$ West 131 feet; thence leaving said centerline of Diablo Avenue North $60^{\circ} 45'$ West 105.0 feet to a point on said Sanitary District boundary; running thence along said Sanitary District boundary North $29^{\circ} 15'$ East 8 feet, more or less, to a point on the Northerly line of that certain tract of land conveyed to Alfred Bellucci and Frank DeMello by deed dated February 27, 1961 and recorded in Volume 1439 at Page 507, Marin County Records, thence Westerly along said Northerly line of said tract of land 225 feet, more or less, to the most Northerly corner of the above mentioned tract, said point being also on the Westerly line of said Lot 96; thence leaving said Sanitary District boundary and running along said Westerly line of Lot 96 North $29^{\circ} 15'$ East to the most Northerly corner of said Lot 96, said Northerly corner being also a point on the existing boundary of said Sanitary District; running thence along said Sanitary District boundary and the Northerly line of said Lot 96 South $60^{\circ} 45'$ East 330 feet to the point of beginning.
