RESOLUTION NO. 66-38

RESOLUTION MAKING DETERMINATIONS AND APPROVING
THE PROPOSED DISSOLUTION OF THE
GALLINAS VILLAGE SEWER MAINTENANCE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, a resolution of the Marin County Board of Supervisors for the dissolution of Gallinas Village Sewer Maintenance District was heretofore filed with the Executive Officer of this Local Agency Formation Commission and said Executive Officer has examined said resolution and found it to be mandatory; and

WHEREAS, at the time and in the form and manner provided by law, said Executive Officer has given notice of a public hearing by this Commission upon said resolution; and

WHEREAS, public hearing by this Commission was held upon the date and at the time specified in said notice of public hearing; and

WHEREAS, at such hearing this Commission heard and received all evidence which was presented or filed and all persons present were given an opportunity to hear and be heard in respect to any matter relating to said resolution,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION OF THE COUNTY OF MARIN DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER as follows:

1. The resolution for the dissolution of the Gallinas Village Sewer Maintenance District is approved.
2. During the five years immediately preceding the date of this resolution the following conditions existed concerning Gallinas Village Sewer Maintenance District:
 - (a) The District has failed to furnish any services or provide any facilities for the use or benefit of residents of the District.
 - (b) No tax has been levied, fixed, or collected nor have assessments, service charges, rentals, or rates been expended for District purposes.
 - (c) No members of the Board of Directors of the District have met.
 - (d) The District has no assets.
3. The effective date of dissolution of the District shall be June 30, 1967.
4. The Board of Supervisors is directed to initiate proceedings in compliance with this resolution.


