RESOLUTION NO. 76-34

RESOLUTION MAKING DETERMINATIONS AND DISAPPROVING THE REORGANIZATION
DESIGNATED AS THE GALLINAS VILLAGE REORGANIZATION
INVOLVING THE DISSOLUTION OF THE GALLINAS VILLAGE COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
AND THE FORMATION OF A COUNTY SERVICE AREA

WHEREAS, a reorganization proposal providing for the dissolution of the Gallinas Village Community Services District and the formation of a County service area has been filed with the Executive Officer of this Commission; and

WHEREAS, said reorganization proposal was made in the form of sufficient petition signed by registered voters of the affected territory and filed in accordance with provisions of the District Reorganization Act of 1965, Division 1 (commencing with Section 56000) of Title 6 of the Government Code; and

WHEREAS, at the time and in the form and manner prescribed by law the Executive Officer has given notice of public hearing by this Commission upon said proposal; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing on said proposal was held by this Commission upon the date and at the time and place specified in said notice of public hearing; and

WHEREAS, at said hearing this Commission heard and received all oral and written protests, objections and evidence relative to the proposal which were made, presented or filed; and

WHEREAS, at said hearing the Commission considered and affirmed findings that the subject reorganization would not have a significant adverse impact on the environment;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Marin DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER as follows:


1. The reorganization proposal to dissolve the Gallinas Village Community Services District and form a county service area is hereby denied.
2. In denying the proposal, the Commission urges that residents of the community attempt to resolve their differences with regard to the Gallinas Village Community Services District's budget, tax rate and recreational programs through the electoral and public hearing processes presently available to them. Specifically, residents of the community, are urged to participate in the nomination and election of members to the Community Services District's Board of Directors, and to attend and participate in the regular meetings held by that Board.
