RESOLUTION NO. 66-21

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO

SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 6

SCHUMAN ANNEXATION (1966-6)

WHEREAS, a resolution of application has been filed, together with evidence of written consent of all owners of property within the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has found the territory to be annexed to be uninhabited; and

WHEREAS, the Sanitary District No. 6 has not requested the Commission to hold a noticed public hearing in accordance with Government Code Section 56261.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Marin County Local Agency Formation Commission, in accordance with the District Reorganization Act of 1965, that it does hereby approve the annexation of territory known as Schuman Annexation (1966-6) to Sanitary District No. 6 with the following determinations:

1. Sanitary District No. 6

shall be the conducting District for further proceedings to annex this territory and the Board of Directors of that District is directed to initiate annexation proceedings in compliance with this resolution. Such proceedings may be without notice of hearing and without election.

2. The territory proposed for annexation shall be designated as Schuman Annexation (1966-6).



SCHUMAN ANNEX 1966-6

EXHIBIT "A"

BEGINNING at a point on the existing boundary of Sanitary District No. 6 of Marin County, said point being on the Westerly line of State Highway 101, bearing South $66^{\circ} 51' 44''$ West 84.64 feet from a standard C.H. C. monument located at the centerline of said Highway 101 at Engineers Station $357 + 88.26$ as shown on the State Highway Right-of-Way Record Map for Road IV MRN-A-Sheet 14; thence along said Westerly line of Highway 101 South $40^{\circ} 00' 30''$ East 1,651.73 feet; thence leaving said Westerly line of Highway 101 South $45^{\circ} 49' 09''$ West 244.01 feet to a point on said Sanitary District boundary; thence along said Sanitary District boundary along a curve to the right whose center bears North $37^{\circ} 41' 50''$ East, having a radius of 800 feet, through a central angle of $13^{\circ} 50' 40''$, a distance of 193.31 feet; thence North $38^{\circ} 27' 30''$ West 1,333.05 feet; thence along a curve to the left tangent to the preceeding course, having a radius of 600 feet, through a central angle of $19^{\circ} 28'$, a distance of 203.85 feet; thence North $57^{\circ} 55' 30''$ West 197.08 feet; thence South $81^{\circ} 16' 00''$ East 104.44 feet; thence North $42^{\circ} 18' 30''$ East 28.64 feet; thence North $76^{\circ} 53' 30''$ East 108.82 feet; thence South $72^{\circ} 37' 30''$ East 55.58 feet; thence North $71^{\circ} 37'$ East 97.82 feet to a point on said Westerly line of Highway 101; thence along said Westerly line and along a curve to the left having a radius of 2,051 feet, through a central angle of $1^{\circ} 01' 22''$, a distance of 36.61 feet to the point of beginning.
