RESOLUTION NO. 67-3

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO

Sanitary District No. 6
Pacheco School Site Annexation (1966-14)

WHEREAS, a resolution of application has been filed, together with evidence of written consent of all owners of property within the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has found the territory to be annexed to be uninhabited; and

WHEREAS, the Sanitary District No. 6 has not requested the Commission to hold a noticed public hearing in accordance with Government Code Section 56261.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Marin County Local Agency Formation Commission, in accordance with the District Reorganization Act of 1965, that it does hereby approve the annexation of territory known as Pacheco School Site Annexation (1966-14) to Sanitary District No. 6 with the following determinations:

1. Sanitary District #6 shall be the conducting District for further proceedings to annex this territory and the Board of Directors of that District is directed to initiate annexation proceedings in compliance with this resolution. Such proceedings may be without notice of hearing and without election.


2. The territory proposed for annexation shall be designated as Pacheco School Site Annexation (1966-14).

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Marin County Local Agency Formation Commission on this 2nd day of February, 1967 by the following vote:



PACHECO SCHOOL SITE ANNEX 1966-14

EXHIBIT "A"

BEGINNING at a point on the existing boundary of Sanitary District No. 6 of Marin County, said point being at the intersection of the courses South $87^{\circ} 40'$ East 215.0 feet and North $7^{\circ} 40'$ East 382.0 feet as the same are shown on Sheet 1 of that certain map entitled, "Boundary Plan of Raphael Village, Marin County, Calif.", recorded November 17, 1951 in Volume 2 of Surveys at Page 165, Marin County Records; thence leaving said Sanitary District boundary South $7^{\circ} 40'$ West 228.723 feet; thence South $52^{\circ} 15' 24''$ East 106.671 feet; thence South $86^{\circ} 27' 03''$ East 427.501 feet; thence South $3^{\circ} 32' 57''$ West 90 feet to a point on the Northerly line of Ignacio Boulevard (formerly called San Jose Boulevard); thence along said Northerly line of Ignacio Boulevard South $86^{\circ} 27' 03''$ East 50 feet; thence leaving said Northerly line of Ignacio Boulevard North $3^{\circ} 32' 57''$ East 90 feet; thence South $86^{\circ} 27' 03''$ East 150.087 feet; thence North $10^{\circ} 12' 03''$ West 776.264 feet to a point on said Sanitary District boundary; thence along said Sanitary District boundary South $83^{\circ} 40'$ West 494.804 feet; thence South $7^{\circ} 40'$ West 382 feet to the point of beginning.
